are vs. our - Although many people pronounce these words the same, they shouldn't be - nor do they mean anywhere *near* the same thing! **Are** is the plural conjugation of the verb "to be": "Where *are* we?" "You *are* a beautiful woman." "They *are* going to Europe on vacation." When pronounced, it sounds exactly like the letter "R".

Our, on the other hand, is what's known as a "possessive pronominal adjective" (check the dictionary): "That is *our* dog." "*Our* family celebrates Hanukkah instead of Christmas." When pronouncing the word, it sounds exactly like the word "hour".
